All candidates should have:

Doctorate obtained within the last 7 years (plus 18 months for every child of female candidates)

Experience with coding models of social phenomena (system dynamics and / or agent based)

Ability to function in an English-language research environment

Ability to work well in a team of researchers

Will prefer candidates who:

Have a familiarity with sociological / cognitive / evolutionary theories of religion, ideology and pro-sociality

Have experience with JAVA

Have a strong publication record in international journals

Description of tasks:

The scholarship recipients will participate in the Religion, Ideology and Prosociality: Simulating Secularising Societies project funded by Norway Grants and led by Konrad Talmont-Kaminski and LeRon Shults. They will join a team of researchers at Bialystok, Poland, and Kristiansand, Norway, in developing computer models of key aspects of secularization on the basis of empirical studies in psychology and sociology. The scholarship recipients will be responsible for conceptualizing, constructing, verifying and validating particular models in cooperation with the project leaders and other team members, as well as coauthoring the resulting publications.
